Music Quiz

Look through the piece of music below, then see if you can answer these questions.

1. What clef is the piece written in?
2. What does the time signature mean?
3. Can you name all the notes in the first and fourth lines?
4. What is the *mf* sign at the end of the second line short for and what does it mean?
5. What's the key signature of the piece?
6. How many beats do each of the notes in the first line get?
