


Chicken Licken • Worksheet

fox	hen






2. Put a line through the sentence that's not correct in each of the pairs below.

4. Match the pictures with the speech bubbles.




Chicken Licken • Worksheet

Activity: puppet show



Make these simple puppets, and you can put on a puppet show of Chicken Licken with a friend.

You will need:

- thick black paper or card
- 7 sticks (about as thick as a pencil)
- sticky tape and glue
- a small table
- a piece of cloth to cover the table



1. Draw animal shapes onto thick black paper or card, using the pictures above to help you. Make them almost as big as this paper (except Chicken Licken). Cut two of each.
2. Use sticky tape to attach a stick to each shape, so that you can hold it up. Then glue the second shape on top of the first, so that it covers the end of the stick.
4. Kneel down behind the table, and hold the puppets up so that they can be seen above the table top. Use the sticks to move the shapes and to turn them around. You may have to hold more than one in each hand.
5. Decide what the animals are going to say, and have a practice with your friend. You could try changing voices for each animal.



3. Put the cloth over the table. It's best if you have a little space and a plain wall behind.
6. When you are ready, you can invite your family or friends to watch the show.
