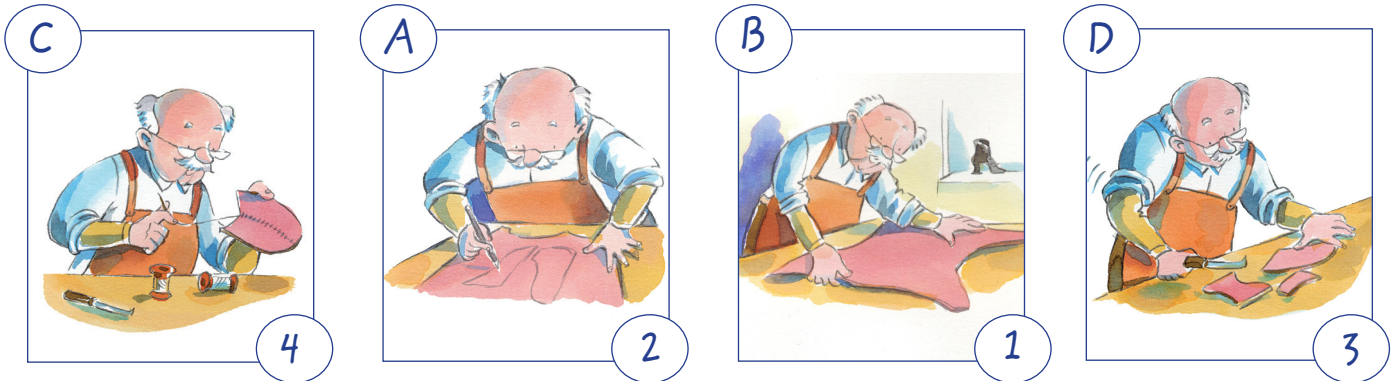


## The Elves and the Shoemaker • Worksheet answers
