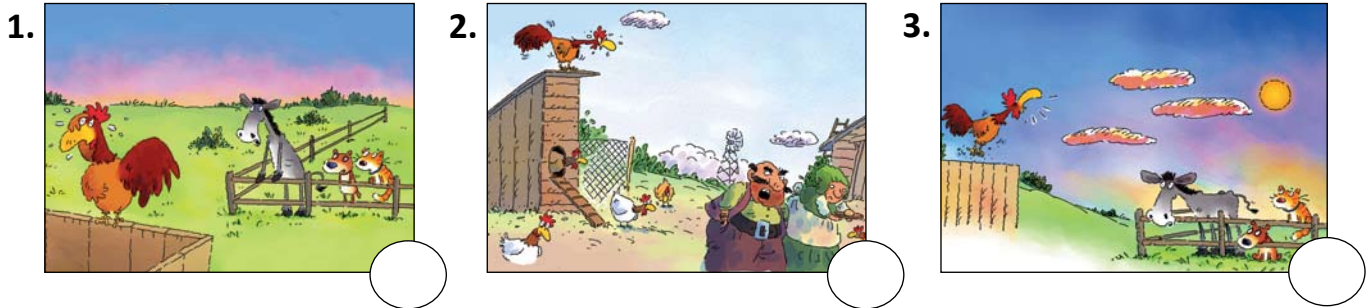




- D. The dog leaped on the donkey's back.


4. Answer TRUE or FALSE.


