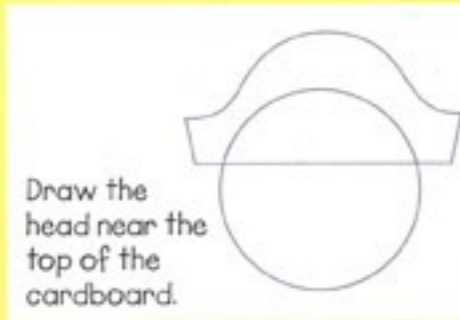


Pirate finger puppet



Draw the head near the top of the cardboard.

1. For the head, draw a circle on a piece of thin cardboard. Draw a line across the circle, then draw a hat above the line.



2. Add a scarf below the hat, then draw ears and a face. Draw a body and two arms. Then, add two lines down the body.



3. Draw a pair of shorts on black paper and cut them out. Lay them below the body and draw around them. Then, lift them off.



Cut a little way away from the pirate.

4. Draw a circle on each leg. Use felt-tip pens to draw over all the lines and fill in the clothes. Then, cut around the pirate.



The holes are for your fingers.

5. Cut up into the circles, then cut around them. Spread glue along the top of the shorts and press them onto his legs.



6. For the pirate's boots, draw a boot on thick paper, making the leg part as wide as two fingers, like this. Then, cut it out.



Push your fingers through the holes, then push on the boots and wiggle your fingers.



7. Fold a piece of paper in half and lay the boot on it. Draw around the boot, then turn it over and draw around it again, like this.

The tab is used when you glue the boots together.



8. Draw a tab on the side of one of the boot outlines. Then, holding the layers together, cut around the shape, including the tab.



9. Fold one of the boots in half, then fold the tab inside the boot, glue it and press hard. Make the other boot in the same way.
